Born in 1938, she grew up in the ancient city of Lahore in the small, cohesive community of Zoroastrians – one of the oldest religions on Earth, with roots in pre-Islamic Persia. When she was just two years old, Bapsi contracted polio, an illness from which it took nine years to recover, but she emerged with a uniquely observant mind, a deep reverence for life, and tremendous gratitude for her family's love and care.

In 1948, while she was still recuperating, Bapsi witnessed first-hand the Partition of India, an event that sparked sectarian riots in Lahore and dozens of other cities. As an adult, she married, divorced, remarried and had three children all before beginning her career as an author. Today, Bapsi lives in Houston, Texas, where she continues to write, teach and engage in other artistic projects. An enlightened soul with an infectious passion for creativity, Bapsi's joys as well as her tribulations have found their way into her stories, as her characters navigate themes of marriage, migration, careers and cultural assimilation.

The Film

We are committed to bringing the inspirational life of this artistic genius to the screen. We have worked with Bapsi since the summer of 2016.
